#### NPS student published

In late Term 2, Mr Gawne worked with a number of year 3 students on a Literacy and Art program called "Special Forever." Special Forever is a water education project for primary schools in the Murray-Darling Basin. Now in its 18th year, it is a joint project of the Murray-Darling Basin Authority and the Primary English Teaching Association.

The project focuses on the water systems and enables students to learn about the environment in which they live, engages them with their environment and encourages students to share feelings, opinions, and understandings with other students.

The class was taken to the John Lake Centre at Narrandera fisheries and also visited the Narrandera Wetlands on the way back to school. From their experiences, they had to create written, visual or multimodal texts for publication on the project website and for the annual anthology of writing and art, giving them an audience outside their classroom.

Two Narrandera Public school students made the final cut and were judged on their Literacy and Art in Griffith. They were Lateisha Bright and Charde Bobbine. final judging took place in Sydney, with Charde earning a spot in the 2011 publication with her work "Bidgee River Fish". Charde has become the first Narrandera Public School student, in the 18 years of this program, to be published, and we are very proud of her achievement.
