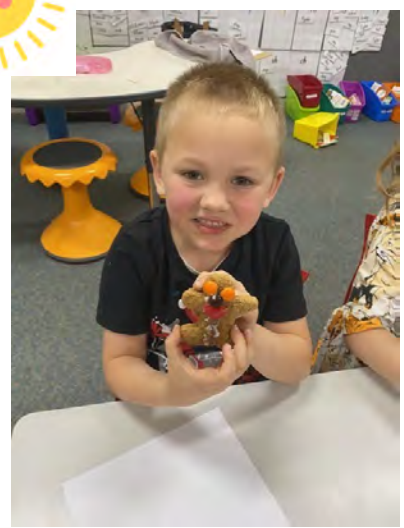
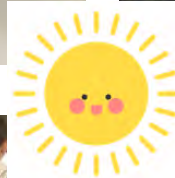
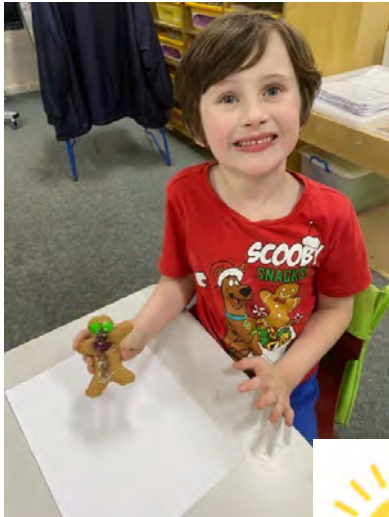
KICKIN' BACK WITH KN
