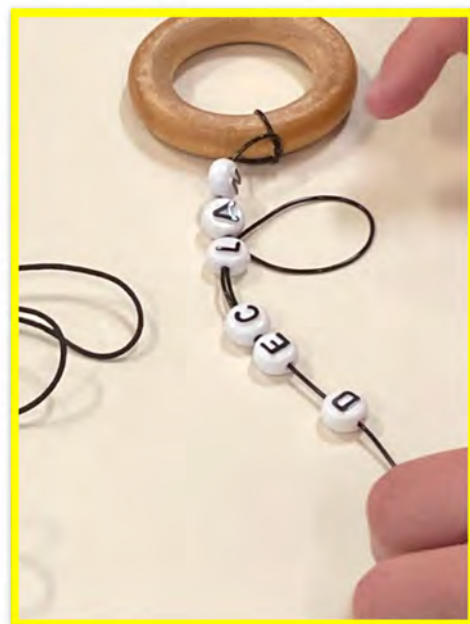
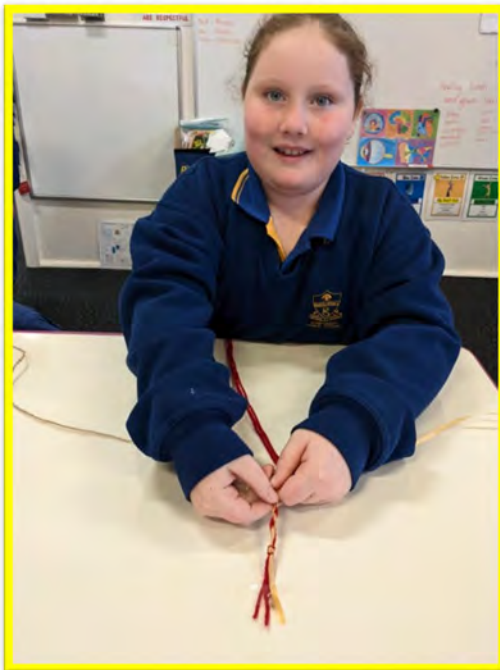
# 5/6K NEWS

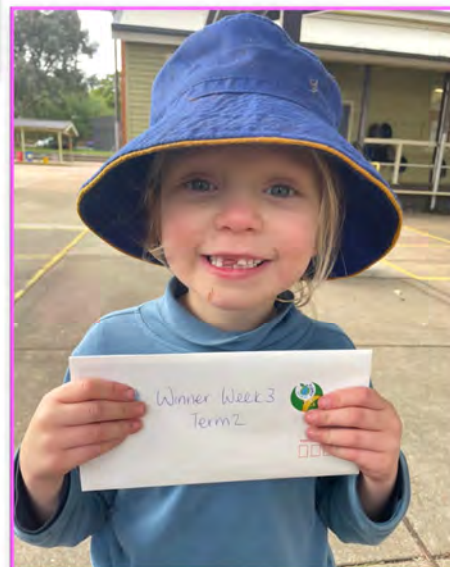

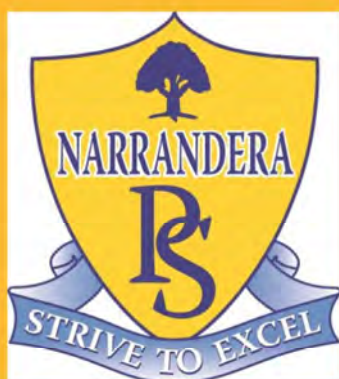
