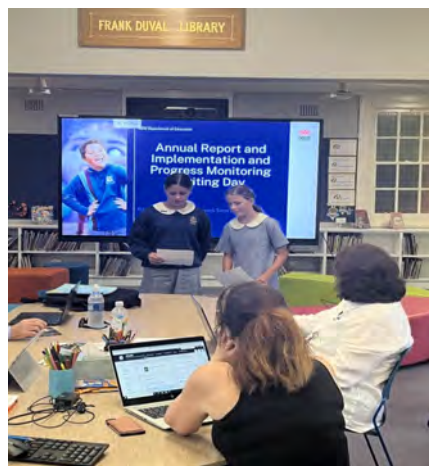
Sport Highlights



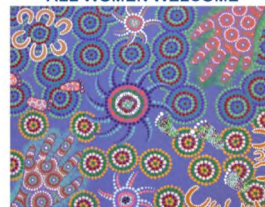
