One tip for getting through NAPLAN is to provide your child with a big healthy breakfast to ensure they have the energy to successfully give each assessment a go.

Slowly but surely, Easter Eggs are starting to appear in the Office to support our P&C Easter Raffle. Please help support this major school fundraiser for our P&C by donating eggs! Raffles tickets are due to the Front Office by Wednesday 5th April.

Each year we ask for your support for our school through your voluntary contribution. This forms an important part of our school budget. The funds supplement the cost of materials used by students in the educational programs over a range of areas and subsidise various activities and ventures like our new playground, to ensure that all students benefit from the contributions. Voluntary contributions are a once a year payment. \$25 for 1 child or \$40 for a family.

If your child is absent from school there is a requirement for you to provide a reasonable explanation for the absence within 7 days. Absences include late arrivals and early departures to and from school and require an explanation. To notify the school of an absence you can reply to our Sentral text, verbal (telephone or in person), email or send in a hand written note. If your child is absent because of illness for more than 3 consecutive days, you will be required to provide a medical certificate with your absence notification. If your child will be absent for an extended period of time, you will need to contact the Front Office and complete an application form for extended leave prior to the leave that is being taken.

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Did you know that cooking together with your child is highly beneficial towards their growth and development? This helps the children to learn about fresh and healthy foods, develop healthy eating habits and enhance math skills.





In NSW Government schools, moving from primary to high school is called the 'Year 6 to Year 7 transition' or simply 'high school transition'.

You will need to complete an expression of interest for Year 6 to 7 transition. The expression of interest lets you indicate which school (s) you would like your child to attend in Year 7. After you submit this expression of interest and it has been assessed, your child will be offered a place at a government high school.

From Friday 4th March 2023, parents will be able to complete the EOI online.

Parents can apply for their child's local school, as well as up to three Out-Of-Area or non-local schools.

The online expression of interest process makes it faster and easier to see your child's options for high school and nominate your preferences for next year.

To start your expression of interest, open your internet browser to: https://year7.enrol.education.nsw.gov.au/?schoolCode=2710

Click on Start expression of interest.

#### The last day for submission is 31 March 2023

Your child is entitled to a place at their local high school. However, it is important that you complete the expression of interest so that your school can support your child's transition to which ever school you nominate.


