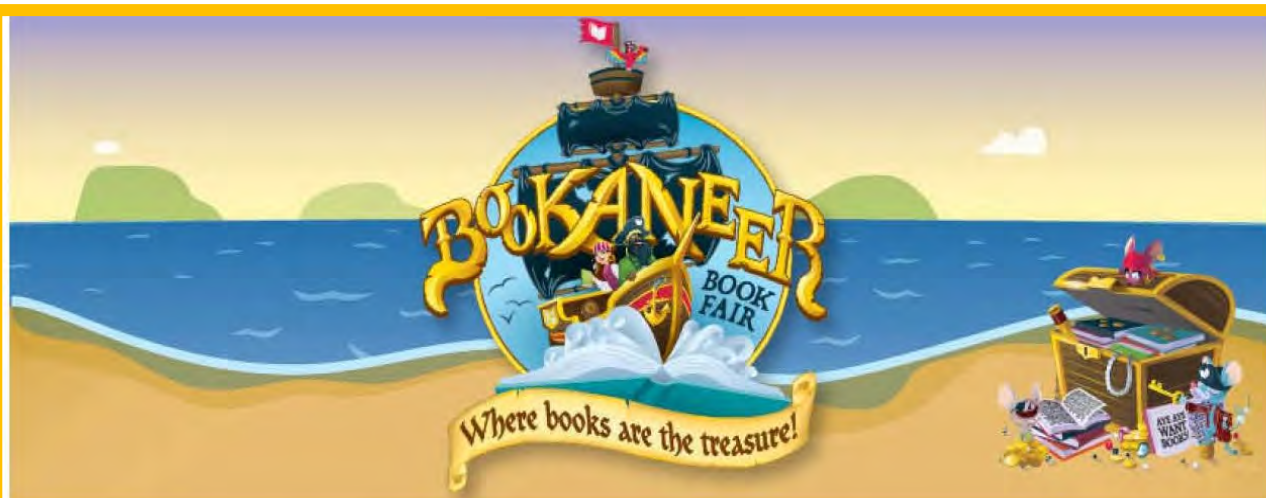


Little Booris playgroup

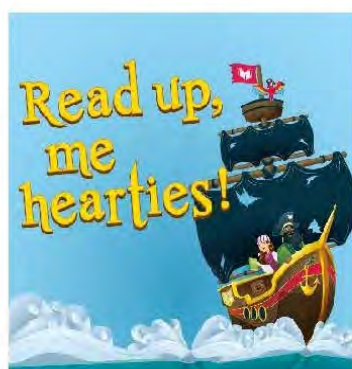

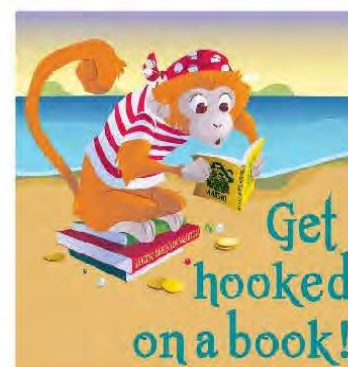
